Applications will be accepted from September 1, 2023 through 5 p.m. on Friday, October 20, 2023 via email only.

No mailed, faxed, handwritten or late applications will be accepted.

Applicants may request up to \$5,000.

Applications requesting \$3,500 - \$5,000 must be matched.



Organizations must be tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and located in or benefit the Crescenta-Canada Valley which includes La Canada, La Crescenta, parts of Glendale, Montrose and Tujunga. "Parent Organizations" located outside but delivering educational programs in this area are eligible.

If your organization is applying for capital equipment, a purchase order or competitive bid must be attached.
