For profit vendors have two choices:

100 for 10' X 10' space only. Must bring own EZ Up, table and chairs. Must set up the evening before (06/21/24) from 5-7:30 pm. Overnight security provided.

\$225 for fully set up 10' X 10' space. EZ Up, table and two chairs will be ready for you Saturday morning starting at 7:30 am. Includes tear down of booth after 4 pm.

Application deadline is June 15, 2024. Full payment must be received by that time.

Please make 2 checks: one for the space fee (either \$100 or \$225)

AND one for the \$75 refundable space deposit.

FOR SPACE RESERVATIONS

An assigned 10 ft. x 10 ft. space will be provided for crafter/vendors for \$100 plus a refundable \$75 deposit. Bring your own set-up as space does not include a structure or electricity. If rentals are needed, we suggest local rental companies Bonners Rentals (818) 951-9117. Set-up of EZ Up tent, table, chairs and banner/s will be between 5 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. on Friday, June 21. Overnight security will be provided. On Saturday morning, unloading of merchandise will begin at 6:30 a.m. with all booths being completely set-up by 8:45 a.m. Vehicles may enter the second driveway south of Honolulu Avenue on Dunsmore Avenue for unloading. Vendors may unload their merchandise in the park, but for safety reasons all vehicles need to be off the grass by 8:30 a.m. and will be directed to a vehicle parking station. Vehicles are not allowed back on the grounds until after the Fair ends at 4 p.m. Tear down of booths before 4 p.m. is prohibited. All leftover merchandise is to be cleaned up. Vendors who tear down before 4 p.m. or fail to clean up their space will lose their \$75 deposit.

FOR FULL SET-UP BOOTH RESERVATIONS

A 10 ft. x 10 ft. space outfitted with an EZ Up tent, 6-foot table and two chairs will be provided on a first-come basis for craft/vendor booths for \$225 plus a refundable deposit of \$75. There is no electricity available. On Saturday morning, June 22, 2024, unloading or merchandise will begin at 6:30 a.m. with all booths completely set up no later than 8:45 a.m. Vehicles may enter the second driveway south of Honolulu Avenue on Dunsmore Avenue for unloading. Vendors may unload their merchandise in the park, but for safety reasons all vehicles need to be off the grass by 8:30 a.m. and are not allowed back on the grounds until after the Fair ends at 4 p.m. Vacating booths before 4 p.m. is prohibited. Vendors who tear down before 4 p.m. or fail to clean up their space will lose their \$75 deposit. Vendors who rented an EZ Up, table and chairs by the Chamber will have the equipment collected after 4 p.m.

This community event is held at Crescenta Valley Park, 3901 Dunsmore Ave. in La Crescenta. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on park grounds. Crescenta Valley Chamber has the right to restrict the type of merchandise sold at this event. For the protection of our vendors, in case of heavy rain or an unforeseen Act of Nature on the day of the Fair, the event will be canceled and no refund can be made (except for the deposit) due to non-refundable costs incurred by the Chamber. There will not be a rescheduled date. Booth assignments are given the morning of the Fair.
